This release replaces the v3.02 series of releases, the last release excluding maintenance releases being v3.02.03.

5 Enhancements

The following feature enhancements have been made in this release:

- GUI notification that the user will logout if they remain idle
- Reboot page detects when the unit has booted and will redirect to the login page
- Network interfaces page re-styled for IPv6 configuration options
- A warning message is now displayed when adding a SCSI target to ID 7
- A warning message is now displayed when adding non-contiguous luns

6 Resolved Issues

The following resolved issues are included in this release:

- NTP failure when receiving duplicate or fraudulent responses
- The user is able to set an IP address in the form 0.x.x.x
- The default gateway is no longer a mandatory field
- Reboot operations would hang occasionally before reboot.
- LANScan now response to all requests, previous routing error prevented response
- The GUI times out when rebooting the unit.
- The manager crashes during vulnerability testing.

7 Known Issues

There are currently no known issues in this release.

8 Upgrading the Firmware

1. Connect to the Manager using your web browser.
2. Log in using the usual password
3. Select the load/save configuration icon
4. Under Export configuration, click on the button that says "Click here to download"
5. Confirm the download of your configuration
6. Click on the "Home" link in the left hand window
7. Select the 'Firmware Update' option
8. Click the browse button and select the '.system' file that you received.
9. Once the filename is in the text box click on the 'Update' button below.
10. If you are updating from a v3.1 series or newer firmware, please wait for the blue progress bar to complete.
11. The web interface will then inform you that the update is complete and that the board should be rebooted.
